It is revealed in the Holy Quran: Sura Al-Isra 17:23&24

قَضى رَبُّكَ أَلَّا تَعْبُدُوا إِلَّا إِيَّاهُ وَبِالْوَالِدَيْنِ إَحْسَ لَكَ الْكِبَرَ أَحَدُهُمَا آَوُ كِلْهُ اوَقُلُ لَّهُمَا قَوْلًا كَرِيْمًا

Your Lord has decreed that you worship none but Him, and that you be kind to parents. Whether one or both of them attain old age in your life, say not to them a word of contempt, not repel them, but address them in terms of honour. (Sura Al-Isra 17:23)

اَجَنَاحَ الذَّلِّ مِنَ الرَّحْمَةِ وَقُلُ دَّبّ

And, out of kindness, lower to them the wing of humility, and say: "My Lord! bestow on them your Mercy even as they cherished me in childhood." (Sura Al-Isra 17:24)

You will never understand what your parents sacrificed for you until you have your own kids.

- The Prophet (PBUH) was asked who should be honored most? He replied: Mother Then who: Mother Then who: Mother Then who: Father (Bukhari Muslim)
- 2. Your paradise lies under mother's feet (Ahmed, Nasai)
- 3. The disgrace for the one whose parents, one or both of then reach old age during his lifetime, and he does not enter paradise. (Muslim)
- 4. Looking at your parents with kindness brings the reward of an accepted Hajj. (Bay haqi)
- 5. The pleasure of Allah is the pleasure of the father, and the displeasure of Allah is the displeasure of the Father (Tirmidhi)
- 6. The best deed is prayer on time and kindness to parents. (Muslim)
- A man came to the Prophet asking permission to take part in Jihad. The Prophet asked, are your parents alive? He said, yes. The Prophet (PBUH) said, then exert yourself in their service (B&M)
- 8. A man asked the Prophet: what rights can parent demand for their children? The Prophet replied, they are your paradise and Hell. (Tirmidhi)
- 9. Three people will not recognize me: who disobeyed parents, abandon Sunnah, don't say salam after my name mentioned.
- 10. O Prophet: I have wealth and a son and my father wants all my wealth. Prophet replied you and your wealth belong to your father (Ibn Majah)
- 11. The person who breaks the bond of kinship will not enter paradise. (Bukhhari)
